



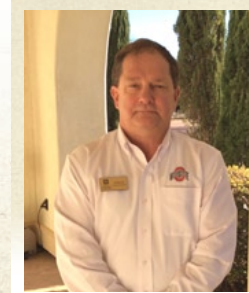

GOODBYE PARTNER EC TOURNEY...HELLO INDIVIDUAL EC TOURNEY!

Now that our Partner EC Tourney is over, it's time to start playing our Individual EC Tourney...an individual competition where you play 10 rounds of golf between May 1st and October 31st and combine your best scores on each hole for one amazing score!

THAT SOUNDS AMAZING! HOW DO I SIGN UP?

Step 1: Determine if you want to play from yellow, combo, or burgundy (soon to be green) tees.

Step 2: Pay \$10 for each tee you decide to play and drop the money off at the golf shop. Envelopes will be there for you to write your name/tee box chosen.

Step 3: Within a week your cards will be ready in the golf shop for you to pick up.

THEN WHAT?

Have fun and go play some golf! Things to know while playing:

◆ Before your round, declare on the 1st Tee that

you will be playing an EC card.

◆ You have to play with at least one CVWG member for your entire round.

◆ Putt completely out to establish your 1st round. All subsequent rounds, only need to putt out when improving a particular hole.

◆ Try to use the scorecards I gave you. Easiest is to just keep in your golf bag.

◆ Have your scorecard signed and attested by a CVWG member that played within your round.

◆ Turn in your scorecard in the box under posting computer in the bar. PLEASE CIRCLE ANY HOLES YOU IMPROVE ON.

◆ Keep your master EC Card with you to track your scores and the 10 rounds played.

◆ Winners will be announced at the Holiday Luncheon

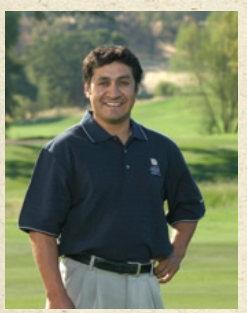

Who Qualifies? The top team will qualify for the Regional Zone Tournament and will represent CVCC as a four person team at the zone tournament July 13-14 at Quail Lodge & Poppy Hills GC. Those who qualify from the Regional event will play Spyglass Hill GC and Poppy Hills GC August 28-29. TEAM ENTRY FEE TO THE QUALIFYING TEAM IS \$640.00/TEAM OF 4. If the CVCC team qualifies for the Zone Championship no additional fee is required. This tournament will play concurrent with the Saturday Men's Event.

TO SIGN-UP PLEASE CALL THE GOLF SHOP AT 916-645-7200 OPTION 1

ELIGIBILITY: NCGA regular members clubs only (one team) Multi members can only represent one club. No players under 18 years of age. A numeric handicap index listed on their club's Master Report on the date of the registration not to exceed 36.4 (men) or 40.4 (women) . All players MUST be a CVCC Golf Member.

FORMAT: Best two balls of four net. Players will be 90% (men) and 95% (women) of the course handicap using a maximum handicap index of 18.4 for calculation. All players with handicap indexes of 18.5 or above are eligible but must play to a maximum current index of 18.4

The Sun is out and great golfing weather is here and it will be here for the next six months. It is incredible how the temperatures shift so drastically. It was in the fifties last week and the temperatures drastically shifted into the nineties. I don't think we are ready for it yet and I know the turf is not either as it did not have a mild Spring to harden going into the heat.

This weather is producing such excessive plant growth. We have not caught up to our normal maintenance practices... Everything is growing out of control. We hope to get everything dialed in before the Invitational.

You can see the staff is all over the course making small improvements. And of course, cleaning up all the piles of chips from the fallen tees during the wet months. We will be cleaning up between six green and seven tees to give it a fresh look at the landscaped area. Thank you for your ongoing support as we get all the turf and native cut down to their normal height.

I hope to see you on the golf course.
