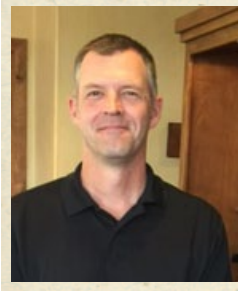

Also held this past June was our Eclectic Tournament. If you're not familiar with the Eclectic, it's where you basically play a best ball tournament with yourself. That is then combined with your partner's best ball score from his 2 rounds to give you your team eclectic score.

Instruction:

Do You 'Decide' to Hit Bad Shots

Whether doing video swing analysis, or simply videoing swings of golfers from varying abilities, I've noticed something that may shock you. Golfers of every ability, from scratch to 20+ handicaps, can make close to the same swing every time, when they are not hitting a golf ball; and most accomplished players can repeat a swing even when hitting a golf ball. Then suddenly out of the blue comes a weird swing and the resulting bad shot. Let me add here that what you are about to read is purely theoretical, and has not yet been scientifically proven. I believe the chief reason that amateur golfers make an occasional strange swing, (and the only reason that PGA golfers make a bad swing) is due to set-up. I'm defining set-up here as Alignment, Ball Position, Grip Position, Grip Pressure, and Decisiveness about

the Shot. When any one of these things is off even slightly, you will have to make a compensation in your swing. This compensation will occasionally fix the error, but more often than not, the result will be a poor shot. The strange swing is not the cause of the poor shot, rather the strange swing was your subconscious effort to fix the poor shot that you caused when you took a poor grip, or put the ball in the wrong place, or aimed wrong, etc... I think the shot of Tigers probably went right because the ball was a little too far back in his stance; though there was no camera angle to confirm this.

I remember years ago watching a Peter Kostis "Swing Vision" analysis of an errant drive hit by Tiger Woods. Not the current Tiger Woods who just won the Masters. The 15 years ago Tiger Woods who was much much better. Tiger had hit the ball into the woods right. Peter Kostis showed the slow motion replay of that drive, and then another that Tiger had hit right down the middle. Kostis explained that the poor drive was hit well right because of a "dropped right shoulder", "hanging on with the hands", and "hips clearing too quickly". I was sitting there thinking "come on Kostis, you're telling me that Tiger Woods can make the exact same swing 1000 times in a row, and then all of the sudden, out of the blue, he makes an extremely different swing." I don't think so, not when the bogey golfers I work with can make essentially the same practice swing every time. The reason Tour players make an occasional strange swing is because they had something wrong with their set-up. Most likely for Tour Pros that error has to do with ball position or alignment. It could be the grip, but they work on their grips so diligently, that it is more likely one of the other two.

The end result of this theory is to inform you that you typically "decide" to hit a bad shot or make a bad swing before you actually set the club in motion. If you have any of the "set-up" essentials out of whack, you will have no option other than making a weird swing in order to attempt to correct your set-up error. Your only solution for this is to come up with a way to ensure you grip the club the same each time, aim

correctly at your target, take the correct stance in relation to the ball location, and then believe you are hitting the correct shot for the given scenario (even if you are not, at least believe that you are). This is all achieved through a pre-shot routine: which is that quick, simple checklist of things you do to prepare yourself to be able to make your normal, natural (just like your practice swing) swing at the golf ball. Putting in this small amount of work prior to starting your club in motion will aid you tremendously in your effort to hit the ball solidly in the direction you desire.

More thoughts on Pace of Play

This past month I had the opportunity to play the Olympic Club. We played it on a Tuesday afternoon, however judging from how busy it was, I would estimate they had close to 200 rounds on the Lakes course which we played that day. We had walkers in front of us, walkers behind us, and our 4 some had 1 walker. With almost no staff to be found anywhere, this very difficult golf course that was packed with tee times every 10 minutes all day, managed to play in exactly 4 hours. No starter, no on course player assistants. Just members all over the course walking up to their shots and hitting them...

I say all this just to remind all our members that our 4:19 pace of play is fairly generous. Please be sure you are getting around the course in no slower than 4:19, and make it your goal when spacing allows to get around in 4:00 or less. And as a common courtesy, be sure to let faster groups play through if you have open golf course ahead of you; regardless of how fast your pace of play is.

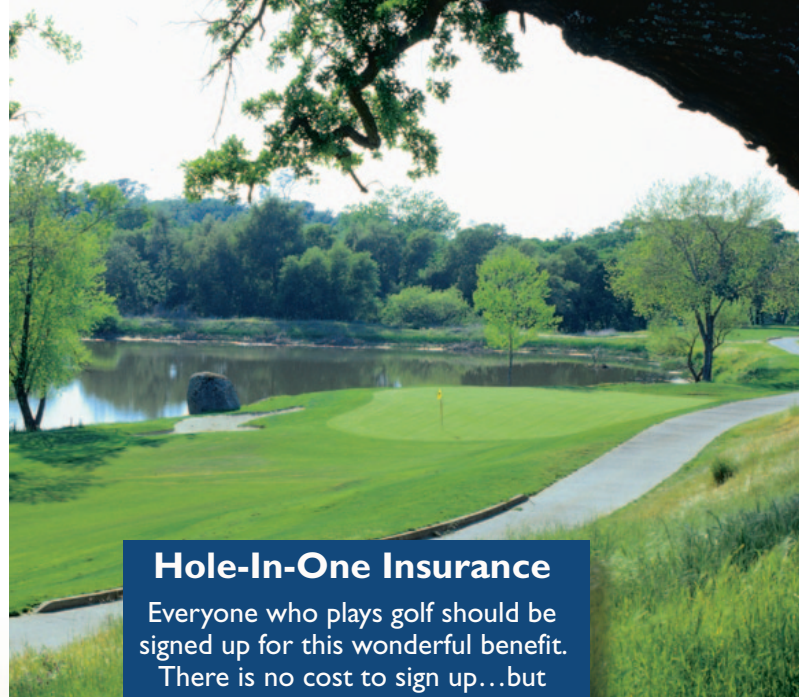

Kyle Verle

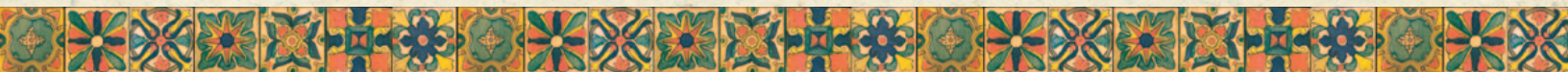

The Dreaded "R" – Have you ever had one?

The definition of a "reduced handicap index" (e.g., 18.2R) is when a golfer has a minimum of two eligible tournament score differentials that are exceptional, at least 3.0 better than the golfer's handicap index. It simply means that you have demonstrated a scoring potential that is better than your current handicap index.

A reduced Index is not “frozen” at a certain level but can fluctuate up or down depending on current postings or old T scores cycling out of the player’s record. As you start playing closer to your T score level, chances are that the reduction will go away on its own!

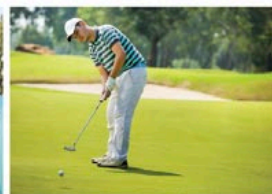

Superintendent Update

We are in full swing of Summer and it's always a beautiful day to be out on the golf course. However, busy times and hot days also bring some up and downs on the course. The Greens are getting a bit compacted from the excessive rolling and mowing. They required a nice needle tining in order to relieve compaction and allow oxygen to the root structure as well. Tees and fairways are getting a little thatchy. They are holding the water on the surface a little too long.

We're getting ready to do a vertical cutting on tees and fairways to prevent further thatch accumulation and improve the playing surface as well as improving the oxygen exchange. It also allows us to mow those areas lower and maintained the surface tighter.

Also, getting back to the cart traffic from previous months. The turf areas with less moisture content tend to get tire burns just like a frosty day. This time of the year is no exception due to the heat. It occurs when the turf's leaf tissue does not have enough moisture to withstand the golf cart traffic. It also happens during frosty days, but turf recovers much quicker in cool periods than it does during this time of the year. Please, maintain the cart inside the fairways. Drive to your ball on the path and make a 90 degree into the fairway continue inside the fairway until the ball is on the green.
